

LESSON PLAN 4 – MAKING MODELS

Objectives: To understand the feeling of being ‘quiet inside’
To represent the feeling of being ‘quiet inside’

Materials: Plastacine / Clay or anything else that children can use to make a model

Duration: 40 mins

1.

Intro 10 mins: To explain in words the feeling of being ‘quiet inside’

Q. How do you feel when you are noisy inside?

Children talk in partners and teacher takes answers.

Q. How do you feel when you are quiet inside?

Teacher writes the words on the whiteboard.

Q. How could you represent those feelings in a sculpture?

Children shut their eyes and think for one minute before sharing ideas with the class.

2.

Activity 15 mins:

Children make a sculpture of the feeling of being quiet inside using plastacine.

Encourage children who are uncertain and help those struggling for an idea. Many children will represent the feeling with a face.

Extension: Make another sculpture representing ‘noisy inside’

3.

Plenary 15 mins: Children present their models to the class.

Individual children show their models.

Other children guess what specific feeling the model represents.

Keep plastacine models to make a display.
